Kankakee Community College is distributing a little more than \$3 million in federal aid to current students for costs incurred on or after March 13, 2020, the date on which the President declared a national emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic. ARP: American Rescue Plan (HEERF III) may be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to the coronavirus pandemic, such as tuition, books, transportation, food, housing, health care (including mental health care), or child care.

KCC students who were enrolled during the fall 2021 are eligible to apply for ARP funds. To be eligible, students don't have to already be receiving financial aid. For those who do receive financial aid, receiving ARP funds will not affect that money.

Funding is available for credit division students, as well as non-degree seeking, non-credit, dual enrollment, and continuing education students. Students who are qualified aliens, international, and DACA are also eligible. KCC students continue to have an opportunity to apply for Emergency Funding from the KCC Foundation. Students may contact the KCC Financial Aid Office for more information on emergency funds.
